### Royal Artillery Hunt Relay

The Inter hunt relay season will kick-off in good military fashion on Saturday, 23 April, courtesy of the Royal Artillery Hunt.

Thirty-two teams are expected to turn out at Knighton Down, Larkhill, Wiltshire, at one of the most anticipated events in the relay calendar.

Last year's winners were the Bicester & Whaddon Chase who beat the North Cotswolds in the final.

The Bicester & Whaddon Chase went on to win the Relay at the Peterborough Festival of Hunting.

Teams will also enter a turn out competition – judged by an ex Royal Horse Artillery Lt. Col and a former Kings Troop Commanding Officer – so the standards will be high!

Racing starts at 10am with opposing teams of riders race each other over a mirror image set of jumps in a knockout competition.

Entry costs £60 per team.

Spectators are also well catered for with a bar, food outlets and clothing and accessories stalls.
